

Questions and answers | Digitizing sectors for competitiveness

Q: Regarding Implementing Partner mentioned in the RfP - is this one partner for all mentioned EaP countries, or each country should have its own Implementing Partner?

A: There is one Implementing Partner for all Eastern Partnership countries mentioned in the Request for Proposals.

Q: Can NGO partner the organization for-profit for applying to this call?

A: No, RECONOMY accept proposals only from the individual non-for-profit organizations.

Q: Could we implement only in 2 countries (Georgia & Armenia), or do we have to cover all 4/5 countries?

A: All countries mentioned in Request for Proposals need to be covered.

Q: Is there any template for the proposal?

A: There is no proposal template, therefore please use your own format.

Q: Can we implement in collaboration with local partners (who could cover tourism or manufacturing) or would we have to implement all activities through direct implementation?

A: Implementing Partner has a facilitative role and works directly with market actors for direct implementation.

Q: Will they award 1 or more contract (what's the total available pot)?

A: Only one contract will be awarded to the selected Implementing Partner.

Q: Should the proposal cover all listed industries (agriculture, tourism, manufacture) or one, agriculture, for example, (or two) is sufficient?

A: Proposal should cover all industries listed in Request for Proposals: agriculture, tourism, manufacture.

Q: In the published RfQ document, it says that 'only not-for-profit/non-governmental organizations registered in Armenia are eligible to apply'. Is this correct or a typo? As from the text of the RfP, it appears that the project is aimed at implementing in 5 countries of the EaP.

A: It is not a typo. RECONOMY is looking for an Implementing Partner based in Armenia to implement activities across all Eastern Partnership countries.
